 - The Locust Swarm Nothing Compared To The Day Of The Lord – Joel 2:1-11
 - No One Will Escape That Day Except Those That Repent – Joel 2:12-27

 - Tongues Came As A Sign And A Witness To Unbelievers
 - It’s Specific Function Was Witness And Judgement

II. Paul’s Quotation Of Isaiah In 1 Corinthians 14:21 – Is 28:1-29; Dt 28:49;

1. Isaiah’s Warning To The Northern Kingdom Of Israel – Is 28:1-4; Isaiah 7:17-18
 - Ephraim: The Largest Northern Tribe, Synonym For The Northern Kingdom
 - They Are A Religious Nation, But Not After God
 - They Have Repeatedly Ignored God’s Warnings And Call To Repent
 - Their False Confidence In Declaring Independence From Assyria
2. “Your Judgement Is Coming And Only God’s Remnant Will Escape” – Is 28:5-6
3. Drunken With Wine And With The World – Is 28:7-8
4. Israel’s Religious Leaders Mock Isaiah’s Message – Is 28:9-10
5. Who Will He Teach? – A Baby?
6. Scornfully Imitating Nonsensical Babbling – Is 28:10, 13
 - Hebrew Repetitive Syllables, Not Full Words – “Babbling” – Tongues!
 - "Beh, Beh, Beh Beah", “Blah Blah Blah”, “Ubleubleubelahbu”
7. Isaiah’s Response To Their Ridicule - 28:11-13
 - “Stammering Tongues” – The Thick, Monosyllabic Language Of Assyria
 - If You Won’t Listen To The Word God Specially Privileged You With:
 - You’re Going To Hear That Word Through The Mouths Of Foreigners
 - “On That Day Will Be Your Judgement” – The Northern Kingdom’s Fall
 - The Assyrian Tongue Is A Sign Of Judgement To Unbelievers

2. What Happened On The Day Of Pentecost?
3. First, Hellenistic, Foreign Jews Heard The Gospel In Their Own Language
4. They Took It Back To Their Native Lands Where It Grew
5. Next, Foreign Gentiles Believe
6. Now God’s Word Is Primarily Proclaimed By Non-Jews In Another Language
7. From Acts 11 Onward, Gentiles Are The Primary Carriers Of God’s Word

V. Without Context, Something Totally Different Than What Scripture Says

1. Tongues As Heavenly Language And Initial Evidence Of The Holy Spirit
 - Ignores The Old Testament Texts Connected With Tongues
 - Misses The Connection Between Acts 2 And 1 Corinthians 12-14

VI. The Consistent Witness Of Scripture Concerning Tongues

1. Presented In The Context Of Foreign Human Language
 - Peter Associates Joel 2 With The Context Of Foreign, Human Language
 - Paul’s Use Of Isaiah 28 Has The Context Of Foreign, Human Language
 - Each New Testament Instance Can Be Associated With Human Language
2. Serves As A Sign Of Judgement To Those Who Will Not Believe
 - Each Old Testament Passage Carries Context Of Judgement On Unbelievers
 - Joel 1-3
 - Isaiah 28:1-29
 - Deuteronomy 28:49
 - Peter Links Joel 2 With Tongues In Warning Of Judgement On Unbelievers
 - Paul Says That Tongues Are A Sign To Unbelievers – 1 Cor 14:22
 - Luke’s Witness In Acts Demonstrates Judgement On Unbelieving Israel
 - Incorporates Judgement Into His Literary Strategy
 - Demonstrates Judgement In The Historical Unfolding Of Events
3. Signals Approval And Blessing To Those Who Will Repent And Believe
 - Consistent In The Old Testament Passages
 - Consistent In Peter’s Application In Acts 2
 - Consistent With Luke’s Literary Strategy And History In Acts
 - Consistent With Paul’s Discussion In 1 Corinthians 12-14
4. We Must Approach 1 Corinthians 14 Equipped With This Information

VII. Why Wait Until It’s Too Late? – Is 45:23; Rom 14:11

1. Sooner Or Later, We Will Have To Acknowledge God’s Word
2. Which Will It Be: For Our Blessing, Or For Our Judgement?

WE BELIEVE that there is one living and true GOD, eternally existing in three persons: The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, equal in power and glory; and that this triune God created all, upholds all, and governs all things.

WE BELIEVE that the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments are the Word of God, fully inspired without error in the original manuscripts, and the infallible rule of faith and practice, and sufficient to guide us in every area of life and human need. .

WE BELIEVE in the person of God the Father, an infinite, personal Spirit, perfect in holiness, wisdom, power and love. We believe that He concerns Himself mercifully in the affairs of men, that He hears and answers prayer, and that He saves all those who come to Him through Jesus Christ from sin and death.

WE BELIEVE in the person of Jesus Christ, God's only begotten Son, conceived by the Holy Spirit. We believe in His virgin birth, His sinless life, His miracles and teachings, His substitutionary atoning death, His bodily resurrection, His ascension into heaven, His perpetual intercession for His people and His personal, visible return to earth.

WE BELIEVE in the person of the Holy Spirit, Who came forth from the Father and Son to convict the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment, and to regenerate, sanctify and empower all who believe in Christ for ministry. We believe that the Holy Spirit indwells every believer in Jesus Christ and that He is an abiding helper, teacher, and guide. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit.

WE BELIEVE that man was created in the image of God, to glorify God as a reflection of Him in His nature and attributes. We believe that as a result of Adam's fall, all people are sinners by nature and therefore are under condemnation; We believe God regenerates all those who repent of their sins and believe and confess Jesus Christ as Lord.

WE BELIEVE in the universal church, the living spiritual body, of which Christ is the head and all who are born again are members.

WE BELIEVE in the Second Coming of Jesus Christ for the establishment of His kingdom. We believe in a literal Heaven and a literal Hell. We believe in the resurrection of the body, the final judgment and the eternal blessing of the righteous and endless suffering of the wicked.
